Eastern North Carolina CPCU Society Chapter's 2022 Good Works Summary



On **March 21st, 2022** we held our annual I-Day seminar whereby attendees were asked to bring donated can goods to be donated to the Food Bank of Central and Eastern North Carolina. A Total of 588 pounds of food were donated which equates to 495 meals. The Food Bank is a nonprofit organization that has provided food for our friends and neighbors facing hunger in 34 counties in central and eastern North Carolina for over 40 years.



On the morning of **April 9th, 2022** volunteers from our chapter assisted Rise Against Hunger in packaging 8,000 meals which were ear-marked and shipped to Ukrainian families that are desperately in need of food supplies. Rise Against Hunger is growing a global movement to end hunger by empowering communities, nourishing lives and responding to emergencies.



On **October 9th, 2022**, members of our chapter partnered with a local Cary church, helping with a Rise Against Hunger food-packaging event. Collectively, we successfully assembled, packaged and boxed a total of 60,000 meals which will be shipped and distributed in both Haiti and the Dominican Republic. Such efforts are always a remarkable process with the knowledge of knowing the impact that it makes in the lives of those who are in need!
